The Sumter County Library employs filtering technology for its Internet computers. Violators of computing resources use policies may lose library privileges. (Staff will be subject to normal disciplinary procedures as well.) Violations of the policies described above will be dealt with in a serious and appropriate manner. Illegal acts involving Library computing resources may also be subject to prosecution by local, state and federal authorities. Specifically, patrons who are found viewing inappropriate materials will be dealt with as follows: First time offenders will be asked to cease using the Internet computer entirely for the remainder of the day. Second time offenders will be banned from using the Internet computers for a period of one month. Third time offenders will be banned permanently from using the Internet computers.
